

Local Emergency Planning Committee

February 14, 2008

Old business:

The Goodfellow exercise to support the March 15th air show took place on February 12th, 2008. The radios linking system had some problems, but were fixed. Overall the exercise went well for Goodfellow AFB personnel. The local civilian members will try to add the 2 Disaster channels to their own radio channels. All members need to be trained that there is a two second delay on most radio repeaters; also Texas Fire 1 will be added.

The interoperability exercise in Eldorado was for the most part a success. There were some initial problems, but all of the issues were corrected

As far as the NIMS level four compliance we are at Level 4, but we need to work on sustainability problems. Our radio networks need to be set up for the long run, and remain constant. The GAFB air show exercise did set up the new permanent radio channels.

Fire Fighter Challenge updates will come out as made available.

New business:

There was an idea brought up by Mrs. Egger to have all agencies bring in copies of their own exercise and evaluation requirements to make scheduling and joint efforts to complete these easier. Also, the LEPC will try to set up their own version of the EET for later exercises.

Mr. Berry (is this correct?) stated that there will be a 3 day exercise in Menard where the event will be a school shooting. The idea of the exercise will be to have the local area handle the shooting at first as best they can. Then have the surrounding areas send in resources. The first day will be briefings, the second day will be the actual exercise, and the third will be a hotwash/debrief.

GAFB is welcoming requests to come and evaluate other Agencies exercises.

Mr. Perry will need to look into whether or not the MACC will be moved into the new EOC.

The LEPC and GAFB will need to put together a Letter of Appreciation to KASN/Kathy Munoz. Mrs. Egger will talk to David about completing this.
