Old business:

Committee reports, Bylaws are still being reviewed by legal. Tammy will send copies of draft Bylaws out through email.

Ron Perry stated the San Angelo EOC is still being developed, updates will be provided to the group as changes occur.

New Business:

There will be a joint exercise with Goodfellow AFB and San Angelo on February 12, 2008. It will be a three phase exercise, with the final phase being held at the San Angelo Airport. The first phase will consist of a communications test between downtown and GAFB disaster response force agencies. The second phase will be an in-flight aircraft accident at the airport (simulated air show accident). The third phase will be multiple scenarios ranging from a bomb threat at the airport to lost children and HazMat contingencies. All contingency plans and checklists will be reviewed during the different phases of the exercises. The updated airport Emergency Management Plan will be used during the exercises. The Goodfellow AFB Search and Recovery team will also be tested and conduct training during the exercise.

MSgt. McGorty is working with Eric Mercado at the Airport to see if we will be using volunteer fire agencies during the air show.
